Animal Awareness




Come and explore the world of animals and their habitats. Along the way, we'll study zoo animals, farm animals, family pets and ocean creatures.

Cool off those hot summer days with a double dip of preschool fun! Come join us for "scoops" of fun using so many different activities like finger plays and arts & crafts.


