

**Crime Alert for period ending August 6, 2013**

**Assaults**

**Dairy Queen, 6017 Rochester Rd, 8/3/13, 8:49 pm:** Troy Officers responded to a complainant of an assault in progress. When Officers arrived they observed the victim with severe injuries to the face, ribs and right leg. The suspect, a 34-year-old from Troy admitted to beating up the victim, stating he believed the victim was having an affair with his wife. The victim was transported to the hospital for his injuries and the suspect was arrested for "ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO COMMIT GREAT BODILY HARM LESS THAN MURDER." were dispatched to a report of a fight in a hotel room involving three women. When officers arrived the fight was over and security had separated the women. Two of the women had sustained very minor injuries. The involved parties agreed to separate for the night and the incident has been turned over to the Troy City Attorney for review and possible charges. Alcohol was a contributing factor.

### **Domestic/Family Trouble**

Troy Officers responded to 14 incidents involving domestic disputes or family troubles during this reporting period. On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of crimes being committed; however, Officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.

### Retail Fraud
