Crime Alert for period ending October 11, 2013

Assaults

Troy Beaumont Hospital, 44201 Dequindre Rd, 9/29/13, 8:05 am: Troy officers were dispatched on an assaultive parent of a newborn. The suspect was upset due to treatment from the birth of his child and did not want the baby to stay in the hospital for care. The suspect was asked to leave and became violent and struck a security officer in the head with a machine from the patient's room. Officers arrived and the suspect became combative with officers as well. The suspect, a 27-year-old from Macomb was arrested for "HINDER & OBSTRUCT" and "ASSAULT & BATTERY." Officers were dispatched to a report of a fight in a hotel room involving three women. When officers arrived the fight was over and security had separated the women. Two of the women had sustained very minor injuries. The involved parties agreed to separate for the night and the incident has been turned over to the Troy City Attorney for review and possible charges. Alcohol was a contributing factor.

Auto/Vehicle Thefts

On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of crimes being committed; however, Officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.
