DUTIES

- Monitor traffic flow to locate safe gaps through which elementary school children can cross streets.
- Control vehicular traffic using signs.
- Safely assist elementary school children in crossing streets and stopping traffic when necessary.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must have a flexible schedule and be able to work Monday through Friday, before and after school.
- As a condition of employment, the successful candidate must pass a background check and pre-employment physical.
