

Winter Storm Update – February 24-25, 2016

Just like every snowflake is unique, every winter storm is unique and requires City Staff to make decisions based on several factors. This has been an unusual winter with little snow, cold one day and warm the next. This particular storm produced a very wet heavy snow. If the City were to plow the subdivision roads this snow would have produced very heavy rows of snow ultimately going in driveways. Weather forecasters predict temperatures to be in the mid 50's in a few days making time and weather on our side. Because of these reasons, the City of Troy Department of Public Works and City Administration has decided not to plow subdivision roads. What we have done is made sure the major roads are clear and safe and we are applying salt to the subdivision road intersections and curves.
