Altercations/Disorderly Conduct:

Kona Grill, 30 E Big Beaver Rd, 11/23/14, 12:14 am: Employee advised a customer was very intoxicated and attempting to drive home. Restaurant staff tried to stop the customer, who then became aggressive and argumentative. Officers spoke to the customer who was highly intoxicated and became louder while talking to officers, using profanities in front of other patrons and causing a disturbance. The suspect, a 42-year-old from Auburn Hills was arrested for "DISORDERLY CONDUCT."

Credit, Check, Identity Theft, Other Fraud:

2000 block of Denise, 11/7/14, 9 am: Complainant advised someone fraudulently used his information to open an Express Store credit card.

5000 block of Bingham, 11/22/14, 8:04 pm: Resident reported someone used her Kohl's charge to purchase a 50 inch television that was delivered to her home.

2000 block of Garry, 11/15/14, 12 pm: Resident advised she received a Visa Credit One credit card in the mail. Resident reported she never applied for the card which has a balance of \$81.95 on the card.

1000 block of Fairways, 11/21/14, 12 pm: Resident advised he received collection calls from Payday Loan. Resident reported he does not have a loan through this company.

Domestic/Family Trouble:

Troy officers responded to five incidents involving domestic disputes or family troubles during this reporting period. On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of a crimes being committed; however, officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, and potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.

Drugs/Narcotics:

3000 block of Helena, 11/23/14, 12:41 am: Officers investigated a complaint of an occupied suspicious vehicle. Officers approached the vehicle and could detect an odor of burnt marijuana. The occupants, a 13-year-old and three 14-year-old from Troy were cited for "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA." One of the 14-year-olds had driven the vehicle a short distance from his residence and was also cited for "DRIVING WITHOUT A LICENSE."

Driving Under Influence of Alcohol/Drugs:

W Big Beaver Rd & Crooks Rd, 11/22/14, 1:05 am: Officers stopped a vehicle for speeding. Officers detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 24-year-old from Royal Oak was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.17%.

E Big Beaver Rd & Dequindre Rd, 11/22/14, 2:24 am: Officers stopped a vehicle after it almost struck a curb. Officers detected an odor of intoxicants coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 23-year-old from Sterling Heights was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.10%.

E Big Beaver Rd & Dover St, 11/22/14, 2:49 am: Officers investigated a vehicle blocking traffic with the driver passed out behind the wheel. The driver had a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person and admitted to drinking. Officers discovered marijuana and a pipe to smoke marijuana under the driver's seat. The driver, a 23-year-old form Sterling Heights failed field sobrieties and was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED," "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA" and "POSSESSION OF NARCOTIC PARAPHRASES." Breath test results were 0.15%.

Rochester Rd & E Long Lake Rd, 11/24/14, 1:57 am: Officers investigated an accident where the responsible driver ran a red light and struck a vehicle. Officers detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the driver's person. The driver, a 26-year-old from Royal Oak failed field sobrieties and was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.13%.

E Wattles Rd & Rochester Rd, 11/25/14, 1:19 am: Officers stopped a vehicle for speeding. Officers detected an odor of intoxicants coming from inside the vehicle, the driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 39-year-old from Troy was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.17%.
