Breaking and Entries:

Allen Group, 1800 Brinston, 11/26/14 – 11/28/14, 4:30 pm - 6 am: Complainant advised the business had been broken into through the damaged garage door. Complaint advised items missing are: two kerosene heaters, white and blue cable, two exhaust fans and some copper pipe. The value of missing items is approximately \$7,000.

Credit, Check, Identity Theft, Other Fraud:

2000 block of Brinston, 11/22/14 – 11/24/14, 12 pm: Resident reported someone made a fraudulent purchase of \$781.92 on her Macy's credit card.

Domestic/Family Trouble:

Troy officers responded to seven incidents involving domestic disputes or family troubles during this reporting period. On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of crimes being committed; however, officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, and potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.

Drugs/Narcotics:

Red Roof, 2350 Rochester Rd, 11/30/14, 2:35 am: Officers investigated an occupied vehicle in the lot. Officers observed the suspect drop something and when the suspect

rolled down the window a cloud of suspected burnt marijuana smoke escaped the vehicle. Officers observed a baggie of marijuana on the gear shift. The suspect, a 32-year-old from Warren was cited for "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA."

Driving Under Influence of Alcohol/Drugs:

Glenshire & Crooks Rd, 11/25/14, 5:30 pm: Officers investigated a vehicle in the middle of the road with the driver asleep at the wheel. The driver woke up and drove his vehicle into the front of the police vehicle. The driver smelled strongly of alcohol and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 31-year-old from Troy was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.41%.

E Big Beaver Rd & Rochester Rd, 11/26/14, 3:33 pm: Officers stopped a vehicle which struck the curb. Officers detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the driver and also there was a young child in the vehicle. The driver denied drinking however failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 47-year-old from Roseville was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED" and "CHILD ENDANGERMENT." A blood draw was conducted with results pending.

I-75 & W Fourteen Mile Rd, 11/26/14, 11:15 pm: Officers stopped a vehicle for a red light violation. Officers noted there was an odor of intoxicants and marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. Officers discovered marijuana in the vehicle. The driver, a 24-year-old from Ann Arbor was arrested for "OPERATING UNDER THE PRESENCE OF DRUGS" and "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA." A blood draw was conducted with results pending.

W Long Lake Rd & Crooks Rd, 11/27/14, 2:25 am: Officers stopped a vehicle which almost crashed into a police vehicle which was assisting on another traffic stop by a second police vehicle. The driver failed to stop for officer's lights and sirens and had to be blocked in by patrol cars to get the vehicle to stop. The driver smelled strongly of intoxicants and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 33-year-old from Troy was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED" and "DISOBEY POLICE OFFICERS SIGNAL." Breath test results were 0.18%.

I-75 & Adams Rd, 11/27/14, 7:26 pm: Officers stopped a vehicle failing to maintain its lane. Officers detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from the driver's breath. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 51-year-old from Royal Oak was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.23%.

Polish Market, 29358 E Maple Rd, 11/28/14, 11:47 pm: Officers responded to a complaint of a drunk driver. Witnesses stated the driver was drinking a beer while operating the vehicle in the lot and almost striking another vehicle. Officers located the vehicle and driver and could smell an odor of intoxicants coming from the driver. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 60-year-old from Berkley was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.11%.

Dequindre Rd & English Dr, 11/28/14, 10:32 pm: Officers responded to a rollover accident. The responsible driver was observed to have a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person. The driver refused field sobrieties and was transported to the hospital. The driver was charged with "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." A blood draw was conducted with result pending.

Rochester Rd & Wheaton St, 11/29/14, 12:47 am: Officers stopped a vehicle which failed to stop for a red light. Officers could detect an odor of alcohol coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 25-year-old from Southfield was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.10%.

E Maple Rd & I-75, 11/29/14, 2:22 am: Officers stopped a vehicle for speeding. Officers detected an odor of intoxicants coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 34-year-old from Sterling Heights was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.14%.

E Big Beaver Rd & John R Rd, 11/29/14, 2:34 am: Officers stopped a vehicle for weaving out of its lane. Officers detected an odor of alcohol coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver had prior convictions for drunk driving and also had marijuana in his vehicle. The driver, a 32-year-old from Farmington Hills was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED 3RD OFFENSE" and "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA." Breath test results were 0.22%.

E Big Beaver Rd & John R Rd, 11/30/14, 12:03 am: Officers stopped a vehicle failing to maintain its lane. Officers detected an odor of burnt marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to smoking a "blunt." The driver was found to have marijuana in his pants pocket. The driver, a 25-year-old from Detroit was arrested for "OPERATING UNDER THE PRESENCE OF DRUGS" and "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA." A blood draw was conducted with results pending.

Home Invasions:

1000 block of Key West Dr, 11/25/14, 7:30 am – 4:00 pm: Resident reported she returned home to find her side door had been forced open. Missing from the home was two TV's and an Xbox.

2000 block of Babcock, 11/30/14, 12:30 am: Residents reported they heard a window break in their home and locked themselves in the master bedroom. Resident advised police there were suspects in the home. Officers arrived and apprehended four suspects inside the home attempting to take several TV's, resident's purse, a laptop, cash and credit cards. The suspects, two 18-year-olds from Detroit, a 20-year-old from Detroit and a 20-year-old from Columbus, Ohio were arrested for "HOME INVASION."
