Altercations/Disorderly Conduct:

Troy Beaumont, 44201 Dequindre Rd, 12/10/14, 2:30 pm: Security advised there was a physical altercation between two parties. Security requested all parties involved leave the hospital. The suspect became irate, screaming and causing a disturbance. Officers arrested the suspect, a 38-year-old from Sterling Heights for "DISORDERLY CONDUCT."

Assaults:

Marriott Hotel, 200 W Big Beaver Rd, 12/7/14, 2:43 am: Officers responded to a complaint of an assault. The suspect and his wife obtained a cab ride from the victim. When it came time to pay the fare the suspect refused to pay and became verbally hostile making threats. The victim attempted to get the suspect out of his cab when the suspect punched the victim in the face. The suspect, a 46-year-old from Washington was arrested for "ASSAULT."

Auto/Vehicle Thefts:

Red Roof Inn, 2350 Rochester Ct, 12/7/14 – 12/8/14, 9 pm - 9 am: Complainant advised he parked his Ford F250 truck/trailer in the lot. When he returned the truck and trailer were missing.

Carz Auto Sales, 150 Stephenson Hwy, 12/5/14 - 12/8/14, 12 pm: Complainant advised his 2003 Mazda was parked in the lot due to car trouble. When he returned the vehicle was missing.

Breaking and Entries:

Protofab, 2835 Daley, 11/12/14, 12 am – 12 pm: Complainant advised someone cut the lock to the businesses storage shed however did not take anything.

Credit, Check, Identity Theft, Other Fraud:

6000 block of Parkview Drive, 12/7/14, 12 pm: Resident reported his MasterCard was used to make an unauthorized purchase in the amount of \$844.79.

Domestic/Family Trouble:

Troy officers responded to ten incidents involving domestic disputes or family troubles during this reporting period. On-scene investigation of these incidents did not result in evidence of a crime(s) being committed; however, Officers were required to take non-enforcement actions to either mediate the situation or keep the peace. Readers should be aware that although these incidents did not result in arrest or prosecution, they do represent significant law enforcement resources in terms of time, on-scene investigation, and potential relocation of disputants, referrals to support agencies, peace keeping, as well as detective and prosecutorial review.

Drugs/Narcotics:

I-75 & Rochester Rd, 12/6/14, 1:14 am: Officers stopped a vehicle for speeding. Officers detected an odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. Officers located a baggie of marijuana in the vehicle. The driver, a 24-year-old from Detroit was arrested for "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA."

Driving Under Influence of Alcohol/Drugs:

Rochester Rd & Marengo St, 12/6/14, 2:19 am: Officers stopped a vehicle driving in both lanes. The driver had a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. Officers found prescription narcotics on the front seat of the vehicle. The driver, a 27-year-old from Shelby Twp. was arrested for "POSSESSION OF PRESCRIPTION NARCOTICS" and "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED 2ND OFFENSE." Breath test results were 0.15%.

E Big Beaver Rd & Rochester Rd, 12/7/14, 1:58 am: Officers stopped a vehicle which was swerving so poorly the vehicle was close to overturning. The driver had a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 27-year-old from Troy was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.21%.

W Big Beaver Rd & Brookdale St, 12/7/14, 2:02 am: Officers stopped a vehicle which was swerving. Officers detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 38-year-old from Birmingham was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.04%.

John R Rd & Technology, 12/7/14, 11:11 am: Officers stopped a vehicle which was swerving and nearly rear-ended a vehicle. Officers detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to drinking and failed field sobrieties. The driver, a 34-year-old from Madison Heights was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.26%.

Stephenson Hwy & Maple Rd, 12/8/14, 5:19 pm: Officers stopped to investigate a vehicle with the driver asleep at the wheel. The driver was observed to have slurred speech and a strong odor of marijuana was coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to taking several prescription medications. Officers located ten prescription narcotics in the suspect's purse as well as a small amount of cocaine. The suspect was transported to Royal Oak Beaumont with pending charges of "POSSESSION OF COCAINE," "POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA," "DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED" and "DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS." A blood draw was conducted with results pending.

Northfield Pkwy & Ross, 12/11/14, 12:45 am: Officers responded to a vehicle which had crashed into the median. The driver was observed to have a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person. The driver, a 48-year-old from Auburn Hills failed field sobrieties and was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED." Breath test results were 0.14%.

Crooks & Benjamin Dr, 12/12/14, 2:22 am: Officers stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. The driver smelled strongly of intoxicants and had a suspended driver's license. Additionally the driver had warrants out for her arrest. The driver, a 26-year-old from Detroit failed field sobrieties and was arrested for "OPERATING WHILE

INTOXICATED," "DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED" and "MISDEMEANOR WARRANTS." Breath test results were 0.22%.

The resident arrived home and advised her laptop was missing. Officer conducted an investigation and it was discovered the neighbor was the suspect.
